Dayton, OH – Doors of Compassion takes place March 3rd, 2018, and is a signature fundraising event for Ronald McDonald House Charities of Dayton. All proceeds from the event benefit Ronald McDonald House Charities of Dayton and its mission to provide a “home-away-from-home” to families of critically ill and injured hospitalized babies and children.

The event begins with a delicious dinner prepared by one of the area's elite chefs and served in one of 30 private residences throughout the Dayton area. All chefs are given the same core dinner ingredients and are encouraged to use their culinary creativity to create a unique dining experience for their guest's enjoyment. Dinner locations are randomly assigned to guest pairs, providing a wonderful opportunity for community and business leaders to mingle and dine together.

After dinner, guests come together to share their unique dining experiences at an After Party. The After Party venue is a secret and the location is not revealed to the guests until the evening of the event. The After Party features a decadent dessert & coffee bar, after-dinner libations, live music, raffle prizes, and more!

A special raffle is open to the public, with the winners being announced at the Doors of Compassion After Party. The grand prize is \$4,999—because even one dollar makes a difference.
