HOW DOES IT WORK?



- Your group will meet at RMHC Dayton at your designated time for your list of clues and a tour of the Ronald McDonald House.
- You will split into teams and set out at the same time to search for needed items at local stores within a 10 mile radius of the House.
- Upon completion, teams will deliver items directly to the Ronald McDonald House for tallying scores, announcing winners, and a photo opportunity.

- Scavenger hunts can be customized to fit your schedule, typically between 1 ½ to 2 ½ hours
- Suggested donation value of \$100 - \$200 per team
