



LETTER FROM LEADERSHIP

As we look back on the continued challenges the pandemic brought as it entered its second year, we are amazed at the resiliency of RMHC Dayton staff, volunteers, and families. The last two years have shown us that when we work together, we can not only face uncertainty head-on but overcome it.

At the beginning of the year, RMHC Dayton celebrated 41 years of service to the Miami Valley. Our anniversary coincided with a decision to adjust our hours at the Ronald McDonald Family Room inside of Emmet's Place at Miami Valley Hospital to open even earlier for NICU families.

In early Spring, our lounge area at the House got a major upgrade with new workspaces and tech access as well as new desks and lounge chairs, allowing our families to continue working remotely and to stay connected with their healthcare teams and support systems.

The start of the Summer brought new hope and excitement to the world as COVID-19 cases continued to decline. In June, RMHC Dayton's Board of Trustees voted unanimously to expand the Ronald McDonald House. The following month, RMHC Dayton expanded hours at the Ronald McDonald

Family Room inside Dayton Children's Hospital to serve more families and the House again welcomed back a limited number of volunteers as a part of our Hot Meal Program.

Unfortunately, as Winter arrived so did a new variant of COVID, forcing RMHC Dayton to cancel in-person fundraisers for the second year in a row. Despite the setback, our programming and development teams continued to work together to serve families and to raise funds for our mission with renewed creativity and commitment.

Despite the continued uncertainty, one thing has remained a constant: your support has allowed us to continue our mission to provide community, comfort and hope to families of seriously ill children, and for that we are truly grateful.

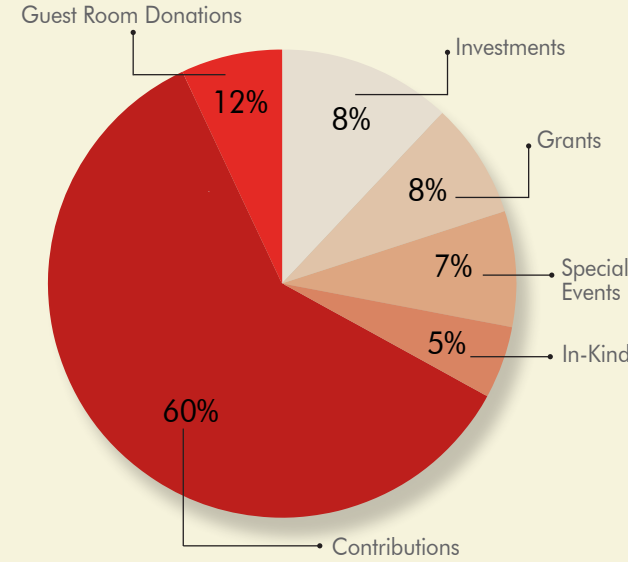

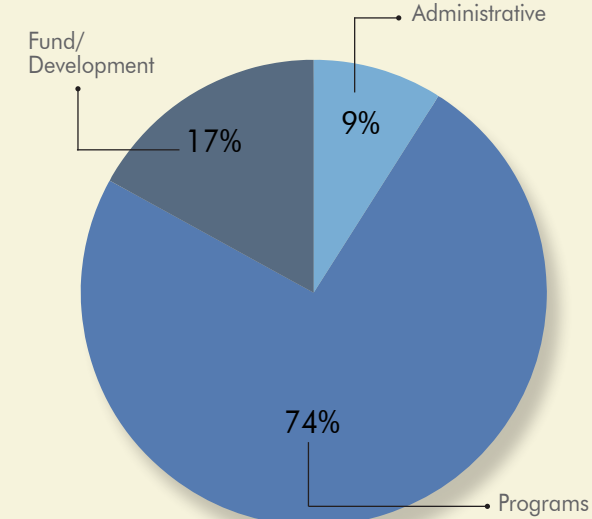

RMHC Board of Trustees voted unanimously to expand the Ronald McDonald House from its current **14-rooms to 42-rooms**. The vote came after years of feasibility studies, focus groups and planning. As our report shows, RMHC Dayton has had to turn away more families than we've been able to serve. This expansion will allow us to welcome thousands more families each year. RMHC Dayton is expecting to break ground for our new building by the end of 2022.
