They go above and beyond to support families of sick children by providing care and respite to help parents and families rest, relax and regroup. They not only take care of the essentials so that parents can focus on what truly matters most, their child, but they work to improve the wellbeing of the whole family by supporting each family member through planned outings, activities and emotional support.

This year we have focused on hope. Hope that we will soon be able to provide more families with a place to rest and heal while their child is critically ill or injured. Hope that we'll be able to take in more families than we turn away. Hope that our new House will provide families with even more opportunities for comfort, and healing through new right-sized rooms that offer them a quiet place to rest their heads.

Through a larger kitchen and play areas with more toys, book, activities and opportunities to play together and heal together.

For the families in our care, hope means something different. They hope for answers. They hope for a cure. They hope for relief and sometimes, just for sleep. In our House and Family Rooms, these are shared hopes that don't feel so different. Our families are bonded by their shared experiences and the hope that they will leave our House and Family Rooms with a healthier child.

In 2022 we had the opportunity to serve 279 families in our House for a total of 3,254 between all of our programs. At the Ronald McDonald House, we turned away a total of 936 families for a turnaway rate of 77%. We continue to work hard each day to change this outlook. We look forward to the day when our turnaway rate is lower than the number of families served. We are proud to serve the Dayton community and provide community, comfort and hope to the families who stay with us from all over the world.

279 families from 36 states, 11 countries, and 34 Ohio counties called the Ronald McDonald House Home.



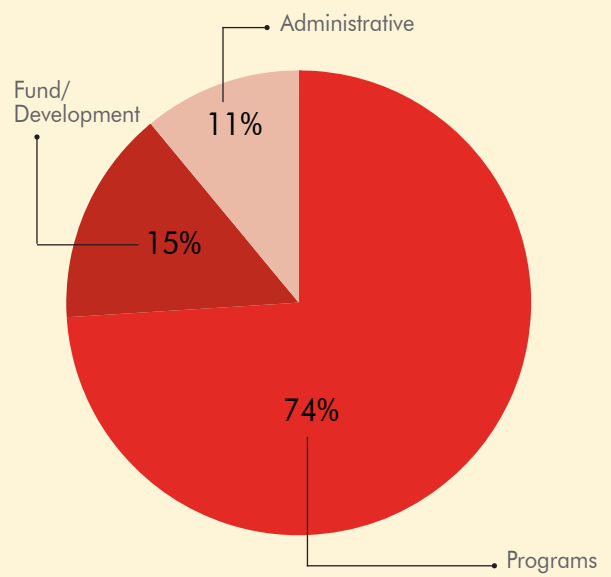
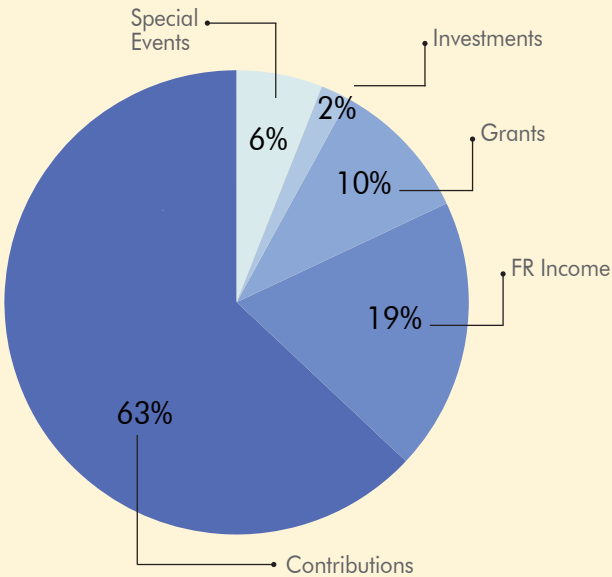

In 2022, we broke ground on the new Dayton Ronald McDonald House. Construction is currently underway for a 38,000 sq.ft. Ronald McDonald House consisting of three finished floors, a partial basement, ample communal space, and inviting outdoor recreation and respite space. Upon completion, the House will have 42 guest rooms, enabling us to accommodate all families in need of safe, comfortable, and affordable accommodations. The new Ronald McDonald House will enable holistic, wraparound services that support family-centered care and help improve health outcomes for pediatric patients.
