Through your support, we embraced 2,544 families facing medical challenges. Our reach expanded across borders, comforting visitors from 15 countries, 27 states, and 35 Ohio counties.

As we approach the completion of the new Ronald McDonald House and expand from 14 to 42 rooms, we are excited to provide holistic, wraparound care services to even more families. In 2023, we turned away 76% of the families

requesting our services. With the new Ronald McDonald House, the possibilities are endless as we expand our array of resources, ensuring that we can meet the diverse needs of our community and keep more families close to their child's medical care.

Of course, all our work would not have been possible without the generous support of donors like you, who have helped to sustain our programs. 



KEEPING MORE FAMILIES CLOSE

2023 saw enormous progress in the construction of our new Ronald McDonald House. This expansion will triple the number of rooms that we currently have available, allowing us to provide even more nights of comfort for families that need it. Thanks to generous contributions and support from our community, we met our funding goal to complete the third floor, giving us a total of 42 guest rooms.

Our anticipated move-in date is Fall 2024 with the opening of 21 guest rooms and staff offices. The remaining 21 guest rooms will open in November, and full completion of the project is set for year-end 2024.

Funding opportunities are still available to fully complete the project. The support we have received over the past year is nothing short of remarkable. It is with sincere gratitude that we thank those who strengthened our efforts to meet the growing demand for our services. As a result of your contributions, this expansion has become a reality, making it possible to care for more families when they need it most.
