
A Comprehensive Campaign to Support Programs and Expansion





RMHC Dayton Programs

Founded in **1980**, RMHC Dayton serves families of children with complex and life-changing medical diagnoses and injuries. We are committed to keeping families close to the medical care they need, the comforts of home they crave, and the family members they could not go through their healthcare journey without.

The current **Ronald McDonald House (1998)** supports families by providing a home away from home at no cost with 14 private guest rooms and comforting amenities, such as:


- e overnight accommodations in private guest rooms
- splay & recreational spaces
- 🚼 non-clinical & sibling support services
- 🗟 daily home-cooked meals

- communal gathering & respite spaces
- 🚿 personal care items
- 🖲 laundry facilities
- *transportation*

The Ronald McDonald Family Rooms at Dayton Children's Hospital (2016) and inside Emmett's Place at Miami Valley Hospital (2017) provide a space for families to rest and regroup without leaving the hospital. These programs are critical to our mission of providing community, comfort, and hope to families of seriously ill children so that they can focus on what matters most: their children.

Impact

Ronald McDonald House Charities Dayton protects the economic status of families. In 2021, RMHC Dayton served **15,618 guests** from **44 Ohio counties**, **27 states** and **6 countries**, saving them **\$1.15 million** in out-of-pocket food, lodging, and transportation expenses.



Growth

Since 2015, RMHC Dayton has grown from one program serving **three service partners**, to three programs serving **six service partners**.

Need


The Ronald McDonald House is a crucial part of the continuum of pediatric care. And with the recent growth in pediatric healthcare specialties in our region, RMHC Dayton has seen a significant increase in demand for housing and outpatient procedures.

A larger Ronald McDonald House will not only support the growing demand for housing for families traveling to Dayton for their child's care, it will also support the strategic growth of our region's health care sector and strengthen our region's economy by **ensuring that Dayton is a destination city for pediatric health care**.

Comprehensive Campaign



A \$6 million comprehensive campaign is underway. This will fund construction of a new Ronald McDonald House with two finished floors, a partial basement, and a third floor shelled and ready for completion. This will also include funding for architecture, engineering, FF&E expenses, and will ensure that doors are kept open to families upon completion with ongoing operating expenses and endowment seeding secured.

Finishing the third floor will be an additional \$3-5 million and will be completed in the second phase of this project.

Reserves

RMHC Dayton is committed to maintaining adequate spendable reserves. It is the goal of the RMHC Dayton Board to have unrestricted net assets of three times the actual total expenses of the prior year.

The organization's reserves have been reduced over the past few years due to significant repairs and maintenance required in our aging building, and revenue losses related to COVID.
